Dear Parents,

With the onset of the cold and flu season, we would like to provide you with information that will promote wellness and reduce student absences. We have had some students out with sore throats, fever, headaches, and stomach aches. We have had no confirmed flu cases but we have had 3 confirmed cases of mononucleosis at the middle school.

We have taken precautions to address the spread of illness among students, including disinfecting desktops, doorknobs, locker handles, and other commonly used surfaces; discussing proper hygiene with students (washing hands, not sharing food/drinks, etc.); and disseminating health information to faculty and parents.

Please talk with your children about taking the necessary precautions to avoid the spread of illness. It is our intent to provide a safe, healthy environment that promotes regular attendance and facilitates learning.
