

Wolfe City ISD Energy Conservation Goals

1. Reduce energy consumption in Wolfe City ISD by 5% a year for the next six years. (HB 3693)
2. Provide resources and training for all teachers, staff, and students on ways they can help improve the energy performance of their schools.
3. Record district energy use and establish a baseline for that use.
4. Continue to design and build new buildings with energy efficiency in mind.
5. Perform energy audits on every building at least once a year.
6. Report energy use to each campus principal every month.
7. Develop Energy Conservations Guidelines in the following areas:
 - a. Guidelines for HVAC
 - b. Lighting Guidelines
 - c. After School Hour Guidelines
 - d. Gymnasium Guidelines
 - e. General Guidelines
 - f. Summer Shutdown and Summer Use Guidelines
 - g. Guidelines for Winter and Spring Break
8. The Energy Conservation Guidelines will not adversely affect the learning environment of the schools.
9. Report energy use and cost on the district web page. (HB 3693)
10. Make annual reports to the board on energy use and energy reduction.
